Robert Adams is an experienced academic, consultant, author and conference speaker. He is highly committed to ethical practice, and has carried out UK-wide as well as locally-based consultancies with many public service organisations and agencies since 1990, including the Open University, Skills for Care and local authority Children's Services departments. His main work lies in learning materials development, management development and the participation of citizens (children and adults) in public services.

Robert Adams worked in the UK penal system for 7 years, latterly as Deputy Governor of a youth custody institution. Later, he was director of Barnardo's first community-based multi-professional project supporting children and families. He was Professor of Human Services Development at the University of Lincoln and currently is Professor of Social Work at Teesside University. Since 1990, he has worked in various capacities with the Open Learning Foundation, a consortium of universities, developing flexible and open learning materials to support students in higher education.

He has authored and edited more than 100 publications, in social policy, criminal justice, education, health and social work. His books include the best-selling, co-edited social work trilogy (*Social Work: Themes, Issues and Critical Debates; Critical Practice in Social Work* and *Practising Social Work in a Complex World*), *Foundations of Health and Social Care*, and several books on empowerment in education and social services, including *Empowerment, Participation in Social Work* which is in its fourth edition since publication in 1990 and has been translated into several languages, including Korean, Japanese and Chinese.
